Abstract Submission- For Scientific Papers and E-Posters

The conference committee invites you to present your research work as oral paper or E-poster presentation. All abstracts will be reviewed by members of the scientific committee. Their decision regarding the acceptance for presentation will be final.

Guidelines for Preparation of Abstracts:

- 1. Abstracts are invited for scientific presentation on Hematology, Histopathology, Cytology, Transfusion Medicine, Microbiology & Biochemistry.
- 2. Abstracts to be mailed to mppathcon2018@gmail.com
- 3. Only registered delegates or registered postgraduate trainees can send the abstract.
- 4. Last date for abstract submission is 31st October, 2018.
- 5. One person can present only one oral paper **or** E-poster.
- 6. Prepare the abstract text in Microsoft word file (doc/docx) in Times new Roman font with font size 12, font color black, line spacing 1.5 & text alignment justified. Typed matter should be in A4 size page with standard margins. The word document should be saved in MS office 2007 or 2010 mode only.
- 7. Maximum word limit is 150 for case reports and 250 for original studies (Excluding title, author & Institutional affiliations).
- 8. Mention type of study as original article or case report/series.
- 9. Mention choice of presentation as; 1) Oral paper 2) E-Poster.
- 10. Case reports will not be considered for Oral paper presentation.
- **11.**Mention Title of study, Full name of authors with designation, Name of Institute and Keywords (all in Block letters). Name of presenting author should be **Bold and underlined.**
- 12. Abstracts of original study should be structured as: Background, Aim & objectives, Material & methods, Results & Conclusion.

13. Time limit for oral presentation is 10 min. (7 min for presentation & 3 min for Que. Answer)

ABOUT ABSTRACT SUBMISSION:

- 1. Abstract should only be submitted by e-mail.
- 2. Once the abstract is submitted, you need not to send additional hard copy or CDs.
- 3. Authors of accepted abstracts will be informed on the registered e-mail by 7th November, 2018.
- 4. Abstracts may be withdrawn by written communication via email by 10th November, 2018.
- 5. All the Abstracts of free Oral papers and E-posters will be reviewed by the Scientific Committee. As per the review, by the committee, some of the oral papers are likely to be considered for poster presentation. IAPM-MP state chapter reserves the right to assign it as Oral or Poster presentation.

PREPARATION OF E-POSTER

- 1. The E-poster should be presented as a single power point slide. File format should be Power point (PPT). Total size of the presentation should not exceed 30-50 MB.
- 2. All presentations should be in landscape format (16: 9).
- 3. Animation/movies/sounds will not be supported; please submit in a static PPT format only.
- 4. It is suggested that font size of the text should be at least 26 to 36 point. The typeface chosen should be a simple and clear one. Avoid use of fancy fonts. Use upper and lower case letters. Use only Times New Roman or Arial font.
- 5. The correct font size depends greatly on the fonts used in the PPT and the thumb rule should be that if it's visible well on the computer screen & it shall be visible on the E-Poster Display Screen.
- 6. The text, tables and graphics should look integrated.
- 7. Gross and photomicrographs should have good contrast and sharp focus. All photos should have legends.

- 8. Color should be used sparingly and not with great contrast.
- 9. References should be written at the bottom in small font size.
- 10. Color suggestions: a) When using light backgrounds (white, yellow, light blue) we suggest using dark fonts (black, navy blue, dark green) b) When using dark backgrounds (blue, purple) we suggest using light fonts (white, yellow, cyan) c) Avoid using red or green in any fonts or backgrounds as they are colors that are difficult to read.
- 11.Illustrations/images/photographs used in the E-poster should be enlarged enough to show relevant details.
- 12. Top of the poster should indicate title, author(s) and Institution(s).
- 13. Presenting author's name has to be underlined and bold.
- 14.Poster presentation should include following titles: For original research: Background, Methods, Results and Conclusions. For case report: it should include Background, Case history and Conclusion.

PREPARATION OF ORAL PAPER:

- 1. Presentations must be submitted in Microsoft Power Point 2007 or 2010 format. For compatibility reasons, it is strongly recommended that presenters use common True Type fonts in their Power Point presentations. Acceptable media include USB flash drive.
- 2. Ensure that all font sizes are large AND line widths are thick enough to be read from the back of the room.
- 3. Ensure that color choices provide high contrast.
- 4. Bring a duplicate copy of your presentation in electronic format.
