PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE

Dear members

2010

We are justifiably proud of our Association. It maintains the tradition of academic excellence by organizing seminars, symposia and guest lectures. To encourage our young pathologists and postgraduates, sufficient time is also devoted to oral and poster presentations. I am sure, you would agree with me that most of the research papers presented and posters displayed during the annual conference are of high quality and that they measure up to the international standards. Every year we find an increasing number of submissions of abstracts for oral and poster presentations and the organizers also make adequate provision for their presentation. This is one side of our success story; when we come to the other side, we find it quite discouraging. There is decreasing number of submissions of papers for different awards. Four prestigious awards have been instituted in the memory of great teachers and pathologists of the past. The purpose is to recognize and acknowledge research conducted in the country and papers published by the researchers. Every year, entries from the members are invited sufficiently ahead of the last date of submission. A panel of experts examine, evaluate and recommend the papers for awards and for the plenary session. In spite of all sincere efforts, response from our members is not satisfactory. It is pertinent to mention here that last year there were only eight entries for four awards, out of which four were for a particular award, and the rest were for the remaining three. There was only one entry for best paper award which was not approved by the General Body. Papers which are selected for presention in the conference even in the plenary session are not submitted for publication in our own journal. I do not find any convincing reason for this declining interest. In the present context, I would like to quote Michael Faraday, the great scientist: "The secret of success comprises three words: Work, Finish and Publish". This was his well known advice to a young aspirant who had asked the secret of his success as a scientific investigator. It is also said that the power of science lies in open publications. Once one starts work, it should be finished and compiled for publication for others to know what some body has done. I sincerely hope our members engaged in the research and publication will realize this and take more interest in sending their entries for the prestigious awards.

IAPM ELECTIONS 2010

- Nominations are invited by the Honorary Secretary for the election to the following posts to be elected through postal ballot.
 - 1. President (one post): Tenure One year
 - 2. Vice President (one post): Tenure One year
 - 3. Honorary Secretary (One post): Tenure Three years
 - 4. Honorary Joint Secretary (One post): Tenure Three years
 - 5. Honorary Treasurer (One post): Tenure Three years
- The duties of the above post are provided in the Bye-Laws of the Association.
- Every candidate for the post of President and Vice President should have at least 10 years standing as Life Member and have served the Association in one or more ways by being an office-bearer, or being a member of the council or Chapter Chairperson or participating in Symposium/ Seminar at the Annual Conference or as an Organizing Secretary/Chairman.
- For all other posts the candidate should have at least five years standing as a life member.
- Nominations are to be made on plain paper duly proposed and seconded by Members who do
 not owe any membership dues (such as Life Members!). The nominated member, proposer and
 seconder should provide their IAPM Membership Numbers and sign the nomination.
- The nominated candidate shall provide (1) a letter of consent and (2) a copy of their bio-data (not exceeding one A4 size page) Schedule.
- Last date for receipt of nominations is: 31 August 2010.
- Last date for withdrawal of nominations is: 25 September 2010.
- Ballot Papers will be dispatched by: 30 Septmber 2010.
- Last date for receipt of Ballot Papers :10 November 2010.
- Ballot Papers will be despatched only to those members who have cleared all dues by 30th June 2010 as notified by the Honorary Treasurer [Part III (Bye-laws of the Association under 8 (Election of office bearers) item (viii)]

The Association shall not be responsible for any delays/non-receipt of ballot papers due to incorrect address/ postal delays or similar circumstances beyond its control.

BEST POSTER AWARD (2010)

To accommodate more free papers during APCON 2010 preference will be given for poster presentation. Those who are presenting posters should bring with them the CD/electronic version of the poster for presentation in plenary session, if selected.

- There will be seven or more poster session on first two days of APCON 2010. In each session the best poster will be adjudged by the judges/reviewers.
- The CD of best posters of each session will be allowed to present in the Plennary Session on 3rd day morning of APCON 2010.
 (3 min for presentation, 2 min for discussion)
- During this oral presentation session the best poster adjudged by a panel of judges will be awarded as best poster APCON 2010.
 The prize will be distributed in the valedictory session of APCON 2010.
